

Step 6


Leave to cool for 10 minutes.

Make a Bird Feeder

Hard cooking fat such as lard or suet


A pine cone, halved coconut shell or plastic pot

String



Mix

Give your dry ingredients a really good mix in with the fat, don't be afraid to get in there with your hands! Making sure the fat is at room temperature will make this much easier.




Make

Grab your feeder of choice and attach the string, if you are using a coconut or pot you may need to put holes in them to thread your string through.



Fill

Fill up your feeder with the mixture! If you are using a pine cone you can spread it all over the outside and in any gaps.




Hang

Hang your feeder on a tree or off your balcony. It's important to make sure it's in a place where the birds won't be disturbed!




Items Needed: A pine cone, halved coconut shell or plastic pot and some string.






Items Needed: Pencil or pen.


Chair Yoga



Cat-cow stretch




Spinal twist




Pigeon
